2017 Ossabaw Island Pig Roast & Art Auction: You're Invited!

On Saturday October 21, 2017, The Ossabaw Island Foundation will host our 16th annual Ossabaw Island Pig Roast & Art Auction.

In 2016, many artists donated artwork to be offered for auction at our 15th annual Pig Roast and Art Auction. That event was canceled due to Hurricane Matthew.

At this year's Pig Roast, we will be offering for auction the donated artwork from last year's canceled event. We are not accepting additional art donations in 2017.

If you donated artwork to the 2016 auction, you are invited to attend this year's Pig Roast. Each donating artist is eligible to receive one (1) complimentary ticket for this year's event. As in past years, we have reserved fifty (50) 2017 Pig Roast tickets for contributing artists, available on a first come, first serve basis.

To claim your one (1) artist ticket, please email Elizabeth@ossabawisland.org by August 30. The first 50 artists to respond will receive a ticket.

Thank you for your generosity to the Ossabaw Island Foundation, and for understanding our dilemma caused by the hurricane. We are grateful for the artwork donated each year. The art auction, and the attendance by contributing artists, is a vital part of the magic of the Pig Roast.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What time does the boat depart?

A: All artist tickets are for the last morning boat of the day, at approximately 11:15am. The exact time will be finalized in late September. (Exception: if an artist is accompanied by a sponsor or general admission-purchased ticket, the artist will be ticketed on the same boat.)

Q: Is my artist ticket from 2016 good for 2017?

A: All artist tickets claimed for 2016 were voided. We have created a "clean slate" for the artist tickets for this year. To claim a ticket, you must resubmit your request.

Frequently Asked Questions (Continued)

Q: What if I didn't want a ticket last year but want one this year?

A: Everyone who donated last year is eligible this year, even if last year they opted not to receive a ticket. But, we only have 50 artist tickets, so the sooner you claim a ticket, the better.

Q: Last year I bought a ticket for a friend and claimed an art ticket. How does that work?

A: Some of you purchased an additional guest ticket for the 2016 Pig Roast. We offered you the option of either donating all or part of that ticket purchase as a tax-deductible donation, receiving a full refund last November, or using that ticket for the Hurricane History Tour & Picnic, or transferring the purchased guest tickets to next year. Please contact our office if you are not sure of your situation in this case.

Q: I donated art last year but cannot attend the Pig Roast this year. May I give my ticket to a friend, or use it in 2018?

A: As in past years, artist tickets are not transferrable, either to another person, or to a different year. They may only be used by the contributing artist for the year their work is donated.

Q: I didn't donate any art last year but I want to give something this year.

A: We are not accepting any additional art donations for this year's Pig Roast. We appreciate your consideration and hope you will support us next year.

Q: When do the Pig Roast tickets go on sale?
